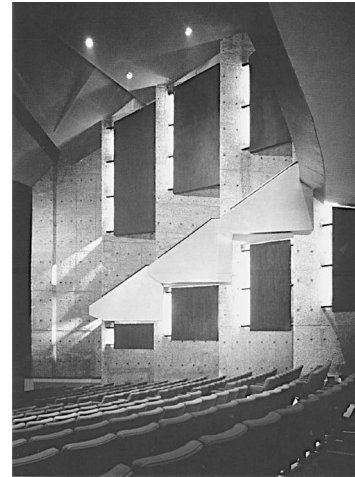

At MIT he was conferred the SMArchS award for best thesis for the acoustics of the Boston Museum of Fine Arts, a



Foster & Partners Project. During his time at MIT he served as acoustics teaching assistant to Carl Rosenberg. He worked at Acentech, an Acoustics firm based in Boston, as a consultant. In 2003 he was recognized with the Robert B. Newman Medal for merit in Architectural Acoustics.

Aside from his work at Saad Acustica, Omar Saad also teaches acoustics at UNAM to graduate and undergraduate students, he serves at the board of the Architecture Department at Universidad Iberoamericana and Tektil. He is also founder and member of Sustentabilidad Mexico (SUME) USGBC representative in Mexico. He has imparted conferences for ASHRAE, many universities and private institutions.

Eduardo Saad, studied architecture at the Universidad Nacional Autonoma de Mexico (UNAM). After graduating he moved to Boston, Massachusetts to study Architectural Acoustics and Climate at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT). 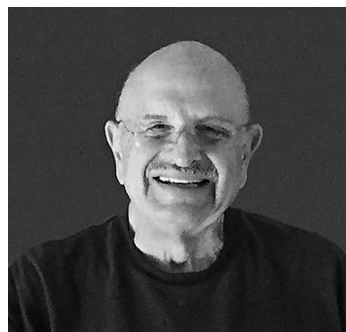

In 2020 he was recognized with the "Biblos Award" from the Lebanese community and embassy for his scientific and cultural contribution and trajectory in the Mexican society.

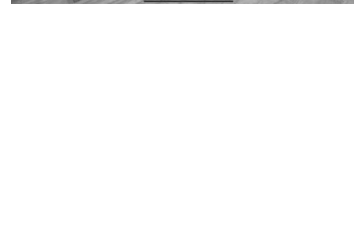
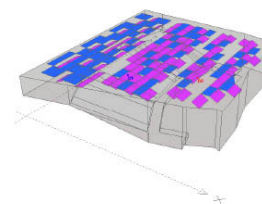
